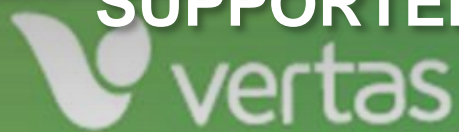




PROPOSED TAXI-BUS TRIAL

Vertas supports Suffolk County Council contracts serving the Priory School. They operate wheelchair accessible vehicles with eight passenger seats, registered as taxis, and these are available for use between school runs.

Vertas can register taxi-bus routes, charging passengers in line with regular bus fares.
